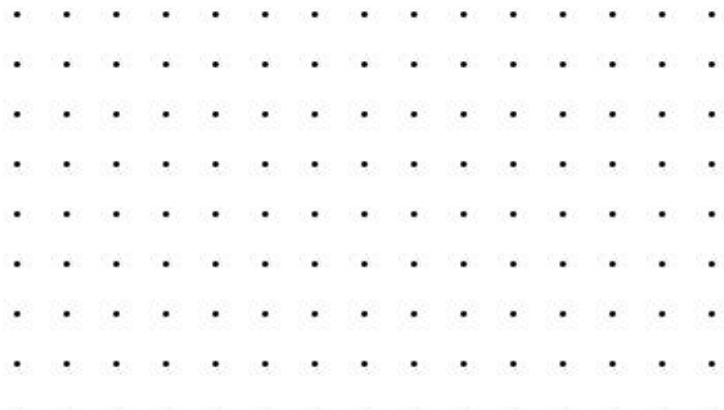

Your goal: be the player with the most boxes when the game is finished. Each person takes a turn making one line between dots. Once a box is completed, the player initials his/her box and takes a free turn.



The Geography Game

You start this one by naming a geographical location (countries, states, counties and cities all count) such as Japan. The next person must name a country whose name begins with the last letter of the previously named country. In this case, Japan ends in N, so a country which begins with N must be named such as Nigeria. Then, since Nigeria ends in an A, the next person's country must start with an A. Each person has 15 seconds to come up with a geographic location. Any longer than this and they get a point; get three points and you are out of the game. Last person standing is the winner.

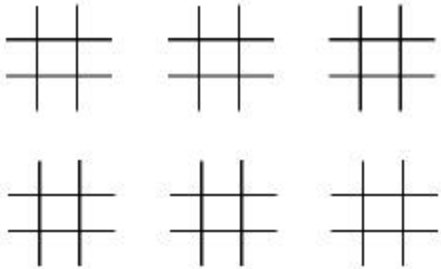
