Thanks again for talking with me on the phone last week about your concerns regarding the webpage http://www.thehightrailsway.com/OEReview.html. As we state on the page itself, we do encourage you to contact us if you feel like your school is not accurately represented. I just took a quick look through the website http://ito.ocde.us/Programs/OutdoorScienceSchool.htm to verify your concerns; you can see my findings below.

- Online Enrollment: http://ito.ocde.us/ito/SignIn.asp you do have online enrollment, and we have updated this on the above webpage.
- Adventure Classes: http://ito.ocde.us/Programs/OutdoorScienceSchool/Curriculum.htm I see no mention of adventure classes like Climbing, Archery, etc.
- **Teambuilding is a primary focus:** http://ito.ocde.us/Programs/OutdoorScienceSchool/Curriculum.htm I see no mention of teambuilding.
- Instruction provided for all day and night programs: http://ito.ocde.us/FAQ/OutdoorScienceSchool.htm from your website "Teachers lead academic hikes and help supervise science sessions and other activities. Teachers also help supervise students at meals". "Do I have free time during the week? Teachers have free time every evening after dinner and have breaks between meals and activities". From this I gather that you require your visiting school teachers to lead and supervise program. Therefore, instruction is not provided by you for all day and night programs.
- Instructors with college degrees: http://www.edjoin.org/JobDescription.aspx?descriptionID=829 from your website's job description requirements: "Completion of two years of study at a college or university or an Associate of Arts degree". I have amended our webpage to state "bachelor's degrees" to avoid the confusion of a 2 year versus a 4 year college degree.
- Overnight instructors with college degrees: see above.
